Training the Photographer's Eye – Techniques for taking striking photographs

“The Voyage of Discovery consists not in seeking new landscapes, but in having new eyes” Marcel Proust.

A creative photography course which develops the photographer's ability to see the world with 'new eyes'. Participants learn to develop their skills of observation and curiosity, seeing the details, capturing the mood, using colour and the nuance of light.

This course is perfect for those who want to explore their creative vision, develop a strong understanding of their camera equipment and make the most of its features. The content is designed for beginners and intermediate photographers and is suitable for digital and film photography.

CORE SKILLS:

- Light and camera exposure
- Technical camera control, light metering and histograms
- Composition and the balance of form, shape and detail in an image
- Photographing people, including individual and group portraits
- Colour awareness – the effective use of colour and the relationship between colour and light
- Understanding light temperature and white balance
- Photographing patterns and textures

One local group fieldtrip is scheduled, where participants experiment with tools and techniques covered in the course. They work with the tutor to try new approaches and bring to life their creative vision in a real situation.

MATERIALS LIST:

SLR camera or compact camera with manual features. Digital and Film cameras welcome.
