

Art Fair Exhibitors FAQ's

Spring Art Fair Application FAQ's

A few FAQ's for anyone interested in applying to the Spring Art Fair 2025.

Who is eligible for this opportunity?

Our art fairs are open to individual artists that make high quality fine art, we also accept a limited number of jewellers and craftspeople. No galleries or agents accepted. You must be based in the UK to apply.

When is the deadline?

7th February 2025.

How much does it cost/how do I choose a stand?

It is free to apply, but please refer to the Stand Plan & Price List for costs of the stands as they vary depending on size. You can download the Stand Plan PDF here:

Is there a cancellation policy?

Cancellations Policy

Following receipt of your payment after allocation of stands:

- 8 weeks or more before set-up day – full refund if a stand can be re-sold, less 20% admin charge.
- 4-8 weeks before set-up day – 75% refund if a stand can be re-sold, less 20% admin charge.
- 4 weeks or less before set-up day – 50% refund if a stand can be re-sold, less 20% admin charge.
- If your stand cannot be re-sold, you will not receive a refund.

What are the key dates?

Fair Dates & Timings:

Friday 16th May

8.30 am – 3.30 pm – Artist arrival and set up

4.00 pm – 8.30 pm – Open to the public

Saturday 17th May

10.00 am – 5.00 pm – Open to the public

Sunday 18th May

10.00 am – 5.00 pm – Open to the public

5.00 pm – 7.00 pm – Artists' take down

Can I hire the use of a table?

Yes! Extras can be booked in advance via the application form, or just after acceptance for £8+VAT. Tables are all one size: 183cm x 76cm.

Is there a private view / opening?

There is an opening night after set-up on the Friday, from 4 pm to 8.30 pm.

Is the venue accessible?

The Landmark Arts Centre does have disabled access for all of the ground floor where the majority of the fair will be held. Some bookable workshops may be run in the arts centre studio, where access is only via a staircase. Please get in touch if you have any questions, concerns, or requirements.

Image Guidelines

Please provide us with at least FOUR good quality images of your work. One image should, if possible, be of your work on display at a similar event.

Image files must be named in the following format: Exhibitor Name_Title_Medium.

Images must be high-quality JPGs, no larger than 4MB

By submitting these, you are giving permission for the use of your images for promotional purposes: magazines, newspapers, web and social media, and the fair catalogue. We might ask you for high-resolution images 300dpi.

Do I need to be present?

Yes.

Can I apply to both art fairs?

We try to keep both art fairs fresh and exciting for our visitors, who often visit both within the year, so we like to have as much variety as possible. Yes you can apply for both, however, we try to avoid allocating one artist to both fairs, so if you have a preference we suggest you only apply to that fair.
