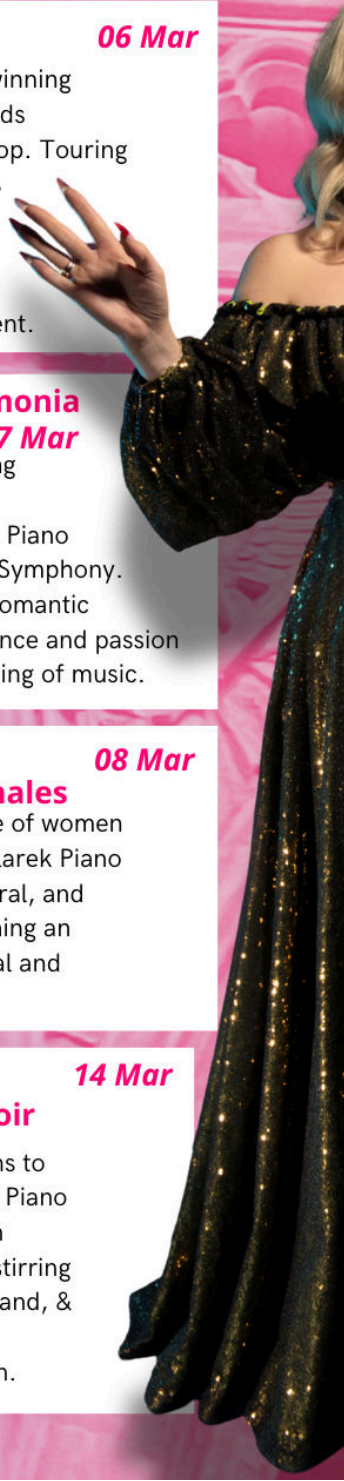

CURATED EXHIBITION - TEXTILES FAIR - WORKSHOPS, TALKS & DEMOS

20-22 MARCH

Material Encounters: Contemporary Textiles in Focus brings together a curated exhibition of large-scale textile works, selected panels from the **UK AIDS Memorial Quilt**, and a full programme of workshops, talks and demonstrations, alongside the return of our much-loved textiles fair.

The Festival offers an accessible and welcoming way to experience contemporary textile art in a dynamic setting. The curated exhibition presents a direct encounter with contemporary textile practice, and we're proud to include selected panels from the UK AIDS Memorial Quilt, recently shown in full at the Tate Modern.

AIDS Quilt UK is a partnership of seven HIV support charities working together to conserve the UK AIDS Memorial Quilt, make it available for public viewing, and ensure it remains a living, lasting testimony to the lives lost to AIDS and the wider social history of HIV activism in the United Kingdom. 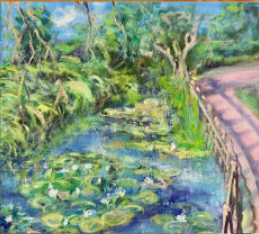
Material Encounters: Contemporary Textiles in Focus 20 - 22 Mar
